Additionally, **all** contestants will undergo the "backstage interview" and "promotion" portion of competition (in addition to Evening Gown & Streetwear)!

WARDROBE: Interview & Streetwear can be the SAME outfit and should be age appropriate – think job interview. For the evening gown portion, <u>teen contestants</u> should wear a short, semi-formal cocktail dress & <u>queen</u> <u>contestants</u> a long formal dress (like a prom dress). You will also need a "little black dress" for the opening number (hopefully no rain this year!)

Enclosed please find the 2018 Doddridge County Fair Pageant Application. You will also be required to sign a contract which sets forth the rules that you agree to abide by if selected as the 2018 Doddridge County Fair Queen or Teen. Please read these rules carefully as they contain much of the information that you need to know. Also, please note that if you are under 18, you <u>must</u> have a parent or legal guardian sign your Contract as well. A **QUEEN** Contestant must be sixteen (16) years of age by January following this year's fair and must not have reached her 22nd birthday at the time of the state pageant (held in January). A **TEEN** Contestant must be thirteen (13) years of age by January following this year's fair and must not have reached her 17th birthday at the time of the state pageant (held in January).

We are proud to announce that the 2017 Fair **QUEEN** will receive an all expense paid trip to the WV Association of Fairs & Festivals Pageant held in Charleston in January 2019, a \$1,000 cash scholarship to further her education and/or career, a clothing allowance, and potentially scholarships to in-state colleges and universities. Both title holders will receive various pageant boutique gift certificates (including Oliverio's, the Queen's Choice, and many more) toward an evening gown an appearance wear of her choice, a custom sash, a beautiful crown, and gift certificates to Tease Me Hair Salon.
