

## 350# AKRA Medium Clone Class

- Must be 15 years of age to compete.
- Weight: 350# minimum.
- Burriss Tires only (smooth-no tread, any compound)
- Open clutch
- 87 Octane fuel only.
- Open pipe (Muffler mandatory)
- Engine must follow AKRA rules.



## 400# AKRA Heavy Clone Class

- Must be 15 years of age to compete.
- Weight: 400# minimum – Driver must weigh 200# minimum WITHOUT equipment (helmet, jacket, etc.)
- Burris Tires only (smooth-no tread, any compound)
- Open clutch.
- 87 Octane fuel only.
- Open pipe (Muffler mandatory)
- Engine must follow AKRA rules.



## General Rules

- Helmet and neck brace mandatory.
- Riding jacket preferred, but must at least have long sleeve shirt.
- Jeans or pants only. NO shorts.
- Gloves preferred, not mandatory.
- Karts must have body.
- Burrell Tires only (smooth-no tread, any compound)
- 87 Octane fuel only.
- You CANNOT drive karts through the pits. Karts must be on stands or pushed through the pits.
- Mufflers mandatory for clones (big pipes) and predators (weenie pipes)
- Scoring barcode must be displayed on the kart body on the nose/side seam above right front tire perpendicular to the seam.
- Safety checks can be completed at any time by track officials. IF you're not deemed safe to compete, you will be asked to be parked until repairs are made to safely participate.
- Lead must be painted white, display kart number or driver's name, and be either double nutted and/or have drilled and pinned bolt.
- All components of kart must be in safe and working order – brakes, steering components, seat properly mounted, have a body, and no missing hardware.
- All safety gear must be in good working condition.
- NO fighting permitted. Driver is responsible for their crews' actions!
- Judgment calls on track. No arguing or fighting with track officials.
- No alcohol permitted during the event.
- Two caused cautions in heat race will result in a black flag for that race. Three caused cautions in a feature or consi race will result in a black flag for that race.
- NO rough driving, intentional wrecking, or retaliation permitted. Driver will be given the black flag during race and parked for remainder of the event at track officials' discretion.
- One minute per lap time limit for each race. (Ex. 10 lap heat race – 10 minute time limit) If time limit is exceeded then the checkered flag will be displayed and race will conclude.
- Be respectful of all competitors, crew, track officials, and fans. Have fun and be safe!

### **350# Medium Predator Class**

- Must be 15 years of age to compete.
- Weight: 350# minimum.
- Burrell Tires only (smooth-no tread, any compound)
- BOB Tire Rule – only one set of tires can be used for the event (Tires used during hot laps will be marked and must be ran during all races during that event. If a tire needs changed, due to a cut or other issue approved by track officials, driver will have to start at tail of the driver's next scheduled race during event)
- Drum clutch only.
- 212 Predator with aftermarket fly wheel. NO factory flywheels.
- Governor can be removed.
- All internal engine components MUST remain stock.
- Must have factory air box and air filter. NO modifications.
- Weenie pipe and muffler mandatory.
- 10.8# valve springs.
- 615 carburetor with 31 max jet.
- Fuel tank can be relocated/aftermarket and auxiliary fuel pump permitted.
